



KOCHUPAMBA ECOTOURISM

Kochupamba Ecotourism, comes under the forest range of Goodirikkal and adjoining Periyar Tiger Reserve.





KOCHUPAMBA JUNGLE CAMP

Night stay in portable tent inside deep forest. Minimum 4 pax required for booking. Dinner will be prepared onsite and served there. Not suitable for children.

TENT- CAMPING ROCHUPAMBA

The programme provides tented accommodations for 10 persons, at a time, in portable dome tents of double and triple occupancy nestled inside the forest. The site is located at the river point in the banks of Kochupamba and Pamba dam view. Stay programme includes trekking, cardamom plantation visit, boating/coracle boating, camp fire, breakfast, lunch and dinner. Kochu Pamba is an abode of variety of avifauna, including, terrestrial and water birds, and is a dream place for bird watchers. Kochu Pamba tent camping provides an opportunity to live amongst nature.
